B. Schedule

- During the examination period you are only required to attend school for timetabled exams.
- AM1 exams begin **at the start** of the session. If you do not have an AM2 or PM exam you may leave school once your paper has been collected. If you have an AM2 or PM exam you should revise in the Assembly Hall until break, and in the Study Room from break until lunch.
- **The Study Room is M1.** Please attend the AM1, AM2 and PM sessions promptly as a register will be taken at the start of each session.
- If you are unable to travel to school later in the day you may attend at 8.45 am and revise in the Study Room until your first exam begins.
- Food will be available for purchase in the Dining Hall during break time.
- You may use the Assembly Hall at break time.
- AM2 exams begin **at the start** of the session. If you do not have a PM exam you may leave school once your paper has been collected. If you have a PM exam you should revise in the Assembly Hall until lunch.
- Lunch is available in the Dining Hall.
- PM exams begin **at the start** of the session. You may leave school once your paper has been collected, or revise in the Study Room until 3.30 pm.

C. Rooms

- If an exam is scheduled for two or more rooms the classes assigned to each room will be posted outside Private Study the morning of the exam.
- Mr. Cunningham will confirm any accommodations that have been put in place (extra time, special chair, etc.) before the exam period begins.
- The Library will be closed during the exam period.

D. Regulations

- All mobile devices should be turned off and left in schoolbags.
- Schoolbags should be secured in lockers before entering large exam rooms such as the Gym and Private Study, or left at the front when taking exams in smaller rooms.
- Only see-through pencil cases are permitted on desks.

E. Absence

- **If you anticipate an absence during the exam period**, the absence must be approved by the Principal before exams can be rescheduled.
- To reschedule missed exams use your school email account to contact Dr Glassey by sending email to internalexams@friends.lisburn.ni.sch.uk. Include your name, collect, and a brief description of the situation.
- Dr Glassey will then reply with an access code that will allow you to reschedule exams by completing the form at <https://wglassey.me.uk/fslexams/reschedule/yr13.htm>.
